




6. 硬體安裝完成。一旦開啟電腦,您的作業系統會自動辨識所裝置好的硬碟。如果您的硬碟 是必須被格式化的,請依照電腦的作業系統進行硬碟格式化步驟。當完成硬碟格式化後, 硬碟便可以進行資料讀寫。

產品使用注意事項

- 1. 電腦或伺服器具備SATA I、SATA II或SATA III介面。
- 2. 具備SATA I、SATA II或SATA III介面的硬碟。
- 3. 強烈建議使用iR2624-S3前先設定好RAID模式(預設值是RAID 1)。
- 4. 在新增或變更RAID模式後需重新啟動產品,以確保完成更新為新的RAID模式。
- 5. 本系統允許使用不同廠牌的硬碟。但如果要獲得更好的效能,我們強烈建議使用相同廠牌型號 的硬碟。
- 6. 安裝硬碟前請先確認所使用的硬碟並無壞軌或是其他問題,以免導致系統損毀或資料遺失。
- 7. 硬碟格式化後,iR2624-S3的總使用儲存容量或許會與硬碟容量加總後的有所不同。
- 8. 強烈建議除了使用iR2624-S3的資料儲存功能外,請針對重要資料備份到另一個儲存裝置上或 遠端備份,雙重備援您重要的資料。若您儲存在iR2624-S3的資料損毀或遺失,RAIDON將不負任 何的責任。

設定RAID 層級

請透過機器後面的 jumper 來設定 RAID 層級。出 廠預設值是 RAID 1°機器背面有三根 pin 腳用來 設定 RAID 層級,若要設定 RAID 0 模式,請選用下 而兩根;若要設定 RAID 1 模式, 請撰用上面兩根。







- 1 RAID 1 模式
- 1). 將新的硬碟放入iR2623-S3中。強烈建議您使用兩顆相同的硬碟,以便取得對等的容量。 如果兩顆硬碟的容量不同,iR2623-S3將會以小容量的硬碟為依據。
- 2). RAID 1模式下, 兩顆硬碟是鏡射關係因此擁有相同的資料, 因此有一顆硬碟損毀仍然可以正 常運作。當放入新硬碟取代損毀硬碟後,系統會自動將資料重建到新的硬碟。
- 2 RAID 0 模式
- 1). 將新的硬碟放入iR2624-S3中。強烈建議您使用兩顆相同的硬碟,以便取得對等的容量。 如果兩顆硬碟的容量不同,iR2624-S3將會以小容量的硬碟為依據。
- 2). RAID 0模式下, 兩顆硬碟的容量會被加總成一個大儲存容量, 並且提供更佳的存取效能。


1. 3.5吋硬碟抽盒的部份,請使用零件包內附的鑰匙解鎖卡榫 按鍵,再將按下卡榫按鍵,硬碟抽取盒把手便會彈開,即 可取出抽取盒。







2. 安裝3.5吋硬碟,請使用6顆零件 包內附的大顆螺絲加以固定;安 裝2.5吋硬碟,請使用4顆零件包 內附的小顆螺絲加以固定。



- 3. 2.5吋硬碟抽盒的部份,請使用零 件包內附的鑰匙解鎖硬碟抽取盒 鎖,將頂出按鍵向右推移,硬碟 抽取盒把手便會彈開,即可取 出抽取盒。
- 4. 將硬碟安裝到抽取盒上,將抽取 盒放入主機內並關上把手。



- 4. When the HDD/SSD installation has been completed, insert the hard drive tray into the system horizontally and secure the latch into place.
- 5. Properly connect SATA cable and power cable from your system to the device.

6. Power on your system after hardware installation is completed, and your operating system will automatically detect the hard drives from booting. Then follow the steps from your operating system to partition and format the drives when necessary, device will be ready to use once the format is completed.

Hardware Requirements and Precautions

- 1. Computers or servers with SATA I & SATA II & SATA III.
- 2. Hard drive with SATA I & SATA II & SATA III.
- You are strongly advised to set the storage mode (the default is the Independent mode) before using the iR2624-S3.
- The product needs to be restarted after adding or changing the RAID mode, and the update is guaranteed to be the new RAID mode.
- 5. The product allows the user to simultaneously utilize two hard drives manu factured by different companies. However, if the user expects better efficiency, we strongly recommend the users to use hard drives manufactured by the same manufacturer.
- Please make sure that the two hard drives are free from bad blocks or defects prior to installation in order to avoid system crashes or data loss.
- 7. The actual storage capacity of iR2624-S3 recognized by the system may differ from the total capacity stated on the hard drives combined once the drives have been formatted.
- 8. It is highly recommended for users to back up important data contained within the iR2624-S3 on a regular basis or whenever the user feels necessary to a remote or a separate storage device. Stardom will not be responsible for any lost of data caused during the use of the unit or the recovery of the data lost.

How to set the RAID Mode

The default is RAID 1 mode. Please set the RAID mode with the jumper at the rear side. For RAID 0 mode, please select the bottom two pins. For RAID 1, please select the top two pins.


- Place two new hard drives into iR2624-S3 and strongly suggest you to use two identical hard drives to get the equal capacity. If the capacity is different, iR2624-S3 is downward to the small hard drive capacity.
- 2). Under RAID 1 mode, two hard drives has the identical information as one to mirror to the other one, therefore each of the hard drive failed is still able to function normally. When you replace the failed hard disk to the new one the system automatically rebuilding the data to the newly place hard disk.

1. RAID 1 Mode

- Place two new hard drives into iR2624-S3 and strongly suggest you to use two identical hard drives to get the equal capacity. If the capacity is different, iR2624-S3 is downward to the small hard drive capacity.
- Under RAID 0 mode, capacity is add up to a one big volume, also with the feature of faster read/write performance efficient.

Hardware Installation

Please follow the instructions below to complete the hardware installation.



•1. For the 3.5" HDD tray, please use the key included in the accessory kit to unlock the HDD tray key lock, and then press the HDD tray key lock. The removable drive tray will pop open and extract the removable drive tray.











3. For the 2.5" HDD tray, please use the key included in the accessory kit to unlock the 2.5" HDD tray key lock and push the HDD eject button to the right, the 2.5" HDD tray handle will pop up to remove the tray.
